Girls



- Plain black trousers with no accessories
- Plain black skirt – knee length
- School polo shirt with badge
- School jumper with badge (if this isn't worn then an outside jacket is not permitted)
- Sensible plain black shoes – no white (or any other colour) sole or stripes/ticks etc
- **No leggings**
- **No jeans**
- **No tracksuit bottoms**
- Natural hair colour

Boys



- Plain black trousers with no accessories
- Plain black skirt – knee length

- Sensible plain black shoes – no white (or any other colour) sole or stripes/ticks etc
- **No leggings**
- **No jeans**

Equipment – please bring all equipment every day in a suitable school rucksack

- Suitable pen (blue or black), pencil, eraser and sharpener, 30cm ruler, calculator, geometrical set (no liquid paper is permitted) to be kept in a suitable pencil case.
- Coloured pencils, not felt pens.

Punctuality – please ensure your son/daughter arrives on time

- All students are expected to arrive at 8:50 am with registration starting at 9:00 am
- Any student arriving after 9:00 am will be recorded as late and will have a break time detention as a consequence. If they fail to attend then the consequence will escalate to after school.
- Should students arrive after 9:30 am then this will be recorded as an unauthorised absence which will negatively impact their attendance and can result in fixed penalty warnings or fines as part of the attendance policy.
