Create a fact file in English about a French speaking footballer.

Find a joke with a French twist.

Find a song in French that you like. Note the title and artist and explain why you like it.

Trace a map of France and mark 5 mountain ranges, 5 rivers and 5 cities on it.

Whilst you are clothes shopping or use the internet to find 5 items of clothes which have a French phrase in them.

Use BBC Bitesize French to learn 3 French phrases. Then teach the phrases to someone else.

Watch a cartoon or film (you can have English subtitles) in French.

Download the duolingo app and practise every day for at least 2 weeks. See how much you can learn!

Find 5 countries which have French as an official language and draw their national flags.

Cook a dish from a French speaking country.
